The point is that if the officer has no search warrant, then put into writing and used in evidence." he has no legal authority to order you to open the door, and submit to a search of the house. He is counting on you to obey because he thinks you will be ignorant of your rights. It's never a good idea to resist with force. In reality, you may want to defend your house against the authorities like a fort or a castle, but it doesn't really work that way. It's a much better idea to ask the authorities why there is a need to enter your house. Remember that the police are required to follow the law just as you are.
